Guidelines & Dress Code:

Tickets purchased on MySchoolBucks should be picked up from Mrs. Allison in the front office during lunch. The ticket will be needed to enter the dance.

If a child is riding home with someone who is **NOT** on the emergency card, the back portion of the ticket must be completed and signed by the parent.

Students are expected to behave in an appropriate manner and to be respectful to peers and chaperones.

This is a casual dance, but students must wear clothing that is safe and appropriate for a school function.

Shorts, dresses, and skirts may not be too short or revealing. Tops may not be strapless, have spaghetti straps, be low-cut, or expose the mid-drift (even when dancing). Clothing may not be torn or ripped or have cut outs. Clothing should fit appropriately, not too tight or too loose. Shoes should be safe.

Clothing should not have logos or language that promotes sex, drugs, or violence.

Cell phones are allowed, but students should not access social media or other websites while on campus. Students should not post pictures of other students to social media without consent.

Only current Ruppel students are allowed. Guests from other schools should **NOT** be invited.

An email will be sent to families if parent chaperones are needed.

Once arriving, students will not be able to leave the dance without permission from faculty/staff and only if the parent is present.

Dismissal will begin promptly at 9:00 p.m. There will be a carpool line in front of the school. Students will not be allowed to walk home or to cross the street to meet a parent.

Only a parent or guardian may pick up a student unless otherwise noted on the permission form found on the back of the ticket. The faculty chaperones will not release a child with anyone else unless permission was granted.

Snacks and pictures will be sold. Students should bring cash for these items.
