Dress Down Day Attire Guidelines:

- Students must wear jeans or pants to the ankle. No cropped pants or shorts are allowed on dress down days. Opaque leggings must be worn under skirts, and skirts should go to the knee.
- Tops worn with leggings must be loose-fitting and appropriate length covering to the upper thigh.
- Shirts should not be low cut, see-through, cropped, or expose mid-drift. Strapless/spaghetti straps are not allowed.
- Clothing may not have rips, holes, or cut-outs.
- No backless or open toe shoes.
- Clothing should not have logos or language that promotes sex, drugs, or violence.
- Students who do not comply with the dress code will be asked to call home for a change of clothes or will receive a minor referral for failure to follow school policies.
